Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Our adventure starts as we enjoy the beautiful desert landscape along the drive to Tucson, AZ, the native home of the stunning saguaro cacti. Have your cameras ready.

Day 2 Our sightseeing begins with the highly acclaimed Pima Air and Space Museum. one of the largest and most diverse aviation museums in the world. The museum has 80 acres of public display grounds, exhibiting over 425 aircraft across 300,000 square feet in 6 display hangars. We then make our way to El Paso Texas where a delicious Welcome Dinner will be served. **B, D**

Day 3 You'll be given a city highlights tour of El Paso before traveling onto the Carlsbad Caverns known for their nightly display of bats flying out of the caves in search of food. After this "show" we drive to Roswell, NM with a 2 night stay at our hotel. **B**



Day 4 Roswell, known for the alleged UFO crash site of 1947 has evolved into a mecca of attractions related to space pursuits. We will visit the International UFO Museum, the Spaceport, Spacewalk and Bricktown. All very interesting venues. Add a stop at the Miniature Toy Museum along with a hosted group dinner topped off by stargazing and your day in Roswell promises to be a memorable and exciting escapade. Keep your eyes open for a UFO even! **B, D**

Day 5 Passing through the quaint town of Ruidoso, we're off to the White Sands National Park, - See the glistening white sands of the world's largest gypsum dunefield – picturesque and stunning! With an interesting Visitor Center and the scenic Dunes Drive, it makes for a delightful morning. We then head to Alamogordo to visit the New Mexico Museum of Space History and check into our hotel. After dinner it's Dark Skies Stargazing on the agenda!. **B**

Day 6 Get your kicks on Route 66 as we venture along this famous highway, enjoying the alluring desert landscape, maybe see a roadrunner or two, and having some fun on the bus. Our Farewell Dinner tops off a good day and we stay overnight in Gallup, NM. **B**, **D**
